

**ACTION PLAN FOR ANTI-DENGUE CAMPAIGN FOR IMMEDIATE
AND INTENSIFIED IMPLEMENTATION**

1. Based on recorded data which point to a Dengue outbreak in nearby provinces, the Division is strengthening its anti-Dengue campaign in order to protect the health, and lives of pupils, students, teachers and personnel.
2. The Schools Division Office of Iloilo City with the 68 Elementary and Secondary Schools will conduct intensified campaign against Dengue by conducting different plans/activities such as:
 - 2.1 INFORMATION DISSEMINATION
Medical health personnel and clinic teachers will give lectures and updates about dengue cases.
 - 2.2 MASSIVE CLEAN UP DAY AND DAILY CLEAN UP
Schools and the division office will dedicate a particular day and time for a mass clean-up. The focalperson will designate specific area assignment for each unit. Suggested time is 4 o'clock in the afternoon.
 - 2.3 MISTING
Focal person will call the City Health Office/Department of Health for scheduling of misting.
 - 2.4 PLANTING OF ANTI-MOSQUITO PLANTS
Schools and Division Office will provide containers/pots for planting of these kind of plants.
 - 2.5 COORDINATION WITH GOVERNMENT AGENCIES, CITY GOVERNMENT, BARANGAY COUNCILS OF BARANGAY ADJACENT TO SCHOOLS, AND PTA
Dengue is a community-based disease that needs coordination with different government units. Meeting with these agencies is encouraged for proper control and management.
 - 2.6 WEARING OF PROTECTIVE CLOTHING
Avoid wearing dark colored clothes (black, dark blue, dark brown) pants, leggings and arm shields are encouraged to be worn.
 - 2.7 USE OF ANTI MOSQUITO REPELLANT
Application of anti-mosquito repellent and anti-mosquito patches are encouraged.
 - 2.8 CAPACITYBUILDING OF CLINIC TEACHERS
Division Medical/Health Unit will conduct Orientations/Trainings for Anti-Dengue Awareness, Control and Disease Management for clinic teachers, advisers and Principals.
 - 2.9 MONITORING OF INCIDENCE
Division Medical/Health Unit will continuously monitor the cases of Dengue in Schools under the Division of Iloilo City.
 - 2.10 REPORTING OF EXISTING CASES
The Medical Health Unit of the Division of Iloilo City in cooperation with the principals and clinic teachers will get the actual number of diagnosed dengue cases.
3. Particular attention is invited to Enclosure No. 1 for the Dengue Campaign Action Plan.
4. Wide and immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is desired.
